A. Approve Adhoc Committee – Candidates for new Interim CEO Presentation

10:03 AM

-Ed Tessier: SAE Foundation Board met last week and started the process of the search committee. Mr. Stevens, SAE Parent, has agreed to co-chair. Will present final search committee at a regular scheduled meeting. Working with Phil Miller, Foundation member, who is supporting best practices among other institutions who represent top 20 or 30 schools similar to the SAE across the country. Meetings held with Dennis from CSMC, 2 representatives from Grow Schools and current interim directors. Proposing salary structure and job duties for permanent director. Rich Vazquez, financial advisor, also doing an analysis. Anticipate two months for completion of job description and salary structure. Information will be public sometime in late summer followed up by a few months after to conduct the search. Timeline is realistic based on other projections. SAE Foundation is available for questions or feedback.

- -Jeff Seymour inquired about how many people are anticipated to be involved and what backgrounds they hold.
- Ed Tessier responded: 7 members currently in committee, but can expected somewhere between 7-9. Previous direction looking at 3 populations: 1 representative of the Board, 1 SAE teacher, and 1 parent. Held conversations with SAETA and some SAE Parents to see if there's any interest in being involved. Process should feel inclusive and defining its visions and governance works.
- -Jeff Seymour: Having been involved in education and serving on different School Districts, there are limitations to how involved a Foundation can be. Are there any restrictions from a legal standpoint if what we are doing is legal and clear?
- -Ed Tessier responded the Foundation is serving as an advisory Board but the ultimate decision will be SAE Governing Board to who they will hire as interim and permanent CEO. They don't have to accept our recommendation, but our intent is to create something collaborative.
- -Kirsten Woo inquired if any current SAE Administration members are involved. Are they pursuing that role or would they be able to be involved and provide perspective about how the school has historically run.
- -Joshua Swodeck made a recommendation to move to discussion item and bring it back to another regular meeting
