Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded.	
In alignment with Prop 28's mission to expand arts education opportunities for students, The School of Arts and Enterprise hired three part-time arts faculty members to directly enhance instruction and student engagement across multiple disciplines: Vocal Music Instructor - providing vocal performance instruction and ensemble development; Visual Arts Instructor and Gallery Curator - expanding visual arts curriculum and managing student art exhibitions; Dance Instructor/ Lead Choreographer - offering technique classes and performance opportunities across various dance genres while supporting school productions and enhancing student choreography and performance experiences. These positions allowed the school to deepen arts instruction at all grade levels, provide more individualized student support, and increase the number and diversity of performance and exhibition opportunities.
